It was recently brought to our attention that there was a serious electrical issue at the tennis court on Lake Flower Avenue within our Village and the Town of North Elba.

Based on the electrician's evaluation, it was identified that there was a safety hazard to the public and it should immediately be fixed. Because of this, the Village has had the work completed instead of waiting until next year's budget.

We ask your consideration in covering half of the cost for the work through North Elba Park's budget. Our reimbursement request is for \$1177.50, which is half of the cost of the work. Enclosed is a copy of the invoice and our check for the payment.

WHEREAS, *It is time to "Stand UP for Character – DOWN to Bullying!"; Now, therefore be it*


